The purpose of this letter is to confirm my desire to continue the existing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed in 2011. The Agency Establishment and Accountability Directive (AEAD) requires that MOUs be affirmed when there is a change in the Minister or the head of an agency.

The current MOU formalizes the relationship between the Minister of Labour and the Director. The MOU establishes a mutual commitment to a cooperative working relationship, while maintaining the appropriate independence of the Office of the Employer Adviser. It also encourages systematic consultation, and facilitates effective and open communication between the Ministry and the agency.


